



Girls with STEAM Series Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What ages are allowed to attend Girls with STEAM series at the Scott Family Amazeum?

A: The series is designed for girls ages 10 to 13.

Q: What will girls do during the series?

A: Girls with STEAM is designed to introduce young girls to all areas of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) over a month. The series meets three times a month. Each girl will engage in a variety of unique hands-on STEAM challenges and social play experiences. The day's activities will combine focused mental and hands-on projects with kinesthetic learning and play. This series is perfect for girls looking for a challenge!

Q: Is there a discount for Amazeum members?

A: Yes! Amazeum members enjoy a discount on the series registration and early access to registration.

Q: How do I sign up for the Amazeum's Girls with STEAM series?

A: You can sign up for the series online through the Amazeum website. In the 'Events and Programs' menu, select 'Camps' and follow the registration link to complete your registration and payment.

Q: Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

A: Yes, the Amazeum will send you an email confirming your online registration. Please check your spam folder and inbox for the email confirmation.

Q: Do I need to sign in and out for each program?

A: Yes, since the Girls with STEAM series is a child drop off program, we require that an adult must escort their child in and out of the program. Only those who have been designated to sign out the girls may do so. Girls may not leave the Tinkering Hub until a designated adult signs them out and provides photo identification. Your child's safety is our top priority; therefore, Amazeum educators strictly enforce Amazeum sign-in and sign-out procedures. **Only adults identified on the registration form as authorized to pick up will be allowed to pick up your child.** Please contact the Director of Education if you need to add or change an adult name. **Adults picking up children will need to present photo identification.**

Q: How do you recommend the girls dress for the Girls with STEAM series?

A: Dress for fun, physical and potentially messy play. Closed toed shoes are recommended.

Q: Should I pack a snack for my camper to enjoy?

A: Yes! Each girl is encouraged to bring a snack, drink and/or water bottle, labeled with child's name. Please bring nut-free foods due to potential allergies. The Amazeum will not provide snacks or drinks. Microwave, refrigerator, and vending machines are not available.

Q: Who are the educators of the Girls with STEAM series?

A: The Amazeum education team consists of highly qualified and trained educators. These educators work closely with our education managers to design and facilitate experiences that are engaging, unique, developmentally appropriate and fun for the campers. An Amazeum education team member

will be actively present at all times during the camp.

Q: We are early birds at our house. Is it okay if we arrive early for the program?

A: Girls with STEAM will begin promptly at the start time listed in the program description. Please arrive on time but no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the listed start time.

Q: Can I attend Girls with STEAM with my child?

A: Girls with STEAM series is a child drop-off program. In order to foster a cohesive experience the series is for registered participants only; therefore, adult guardians and non-registered siblings or friends cannot attend.

Q: Is it okay if we stay after the program and play in the Amazeum?

A: The Amazeum closes at 5p.m. on Thursdays, but come early and play before the program! Program participants get complimentary admission into the museum for the day of the program. Adults and children accompanying the program participant should be prepared to use Amazeum membership or pay admission. Please check in at the admissions desk before heading into the galleries to play. Children must be accompanied by an adult 18 or over at all times.

Q: I need to cancel my registration. How do I cancel and can I get a refund?

A: Please contact the Director of Education at mporter@amazeum.org or 479-696-9280 ext. 206 to cancel your registration. At this time we are unable to offer refunds for cancelled registrations. Please plan your schedule accordingly so that you can attend your selected series.

Q: Can I register for only part of the series, and if so, is there a discount?

A: Girls with STEAM is designed to build upon the experiences throughout the month. Active participation and attendance of the each session will ensure your child has a full experience. Partial registration is not available and a discount is not offered for children that cannot attend all three session in the month.
