



Amazeum You Connect Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Amazeum You Connect?

A: Amazeum You Connect is a weekly opportunity to virtually explore an Amazeum You activity with an Amazeum educator! Every week, you and your family can explore a new activity together from the comfort of your home through Zoom. Don't worry about not knowing the steps, our educators will guide you through your exploration! After registering, you will receive follow up emails with additional details on how to prepare for Amazeum You Connect including supply list and Zoom call link.

Q: During what days and times does Amazeum You Connect happen?

A: Amazeum You Connect occurs on Fridays from 9:00 to 10:00 am CST.

Q: What ages is Amazeum You Connect geared towards?

A: Amazeum You Connect activities are designed for 6-14 year olds, however, families are encouraged to join the Zoom call and do the activity together.

Q: Where will the shopping list be posted?

A: The supply list will be emailed after registering. Amazeum You Connect activities use materials commonly found in households. All materials will be linked to Walmart.com for easy ordering in case you don't have access to a supply at home.

Q: What will happen during this program?

A: During Amazeum You Connect, our educators will join you on a Zoom call with other children and families. We will get to know each other a bit, guide you through our weekly activity, reflect about our experience, and even play games!

Q: Will capacity be limited during this program?

A: Yes! We are limiting each Zoom call to 15 families. This number of guests allows each family the opportunity to share their voice and for our educators to give special attention to each participant.

Q: What is the fee for Amazeum You Connect?

A: Amazeum You Connect is FREE for members and \$5 per login for nonmembers. October and November Amazeum You Connects will be for members only. We are excited to offer this program at a low cost, however, pre-registration is required.

Q: Is a kit provided for Amazeum You Connect?

A: A kit is not provided for Amazeum You Connect. We will send a shopping list with links to materials for our activity in advance so that everyone has the opportunity to shop for any supplies they need before the Zoom call begins. Many of our supplies, however, can be found around your home.

Q: How do I sign up for the Amazeum You Connect?

A: You can sign up for each series online through the Amazeum website. In the 'Visit' menu, select 'Amazeum You' to find your program of interest.

Q: Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

A: Yes, the Amazeum will send you an email confirming your online registration. Please check your spam folder and inbox for the email confirmation. You will also receive an additional email with a video and shopping list to prepare you for the Amazeum You Connect call.

Q: Who are the educators of Amazeum You Connect?

A: The Amazeum education team consists of highly qualified and trained Programs Educators. These Programs Educators work closely with our Educational Programs Manager and Camp Coordinator to design and facilitate experiences that are engaging, unique, developmentally appropriate and fun. An Amazeum education team member will be actively present at all times during the program.

Q: Can I attend this series with my child?

A: Absolutely! We encourage family members to join the Zoom call and do the activity together!

Q: What if I am late or can't join last minute. Will the Zoom call be recorded?

A: In order to create an open and playful learning environment for children, we will not be recording our Zoom calls. However, we will use Flipgrid.com as a way to connect with each other. On this platform, we'll post a guided activity video for those who miss our call. Details on how to access Flipgrid will be emailed to registered participants.

Q: I need to cancel my registration. How do I cancel?
