



4-H Workshops Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Does the Amazeum offer 4-H workshops?

A: Yes! The Amazeum will be offering workshops for Clover Buds and Juniors at the Benton County Extension Office in Bentonville.

Q: What is the location of the 4-H workshops?

A: 4-H workshops will be held at the Benton County Extension Office in Bentonville. The address is 1204 SW 14th St, Bentonville, AR 72712.

Q: What is the fee for a 4-H workshop?

A: 4-H workshops are \$15 per 4-Her. Two 4-H leaders attend the workshop at no cost and are expected to serve as active chaperones during the workshop experience.

Q: How do I register for a workshop?

A: 4-H leaders can registration for a workshop through the Amazeum's Reservation Specialist by calling 479-268-4542 or emailing at reservations@amazeum.org. Advanced registration and payment is required. Registration closes a week before the workshop.

Q: I'm not a 4-H leader but I want to sign up my child for a workshop. Can I register my child separately from the 4-H group?

A: Yes! This workshop is a collaborative experience, so if your child is not attending with a 4-H group, an adult will need to attend the workshop with the child.

Q: If a registered 4-Her is not able to attend, will I be able to get a refund?

A: Payment for the workshop is collected at the time of registration. At this time, refunds are not available once the registration has been confirmed.

Q: What does the workshop registration fee include?

A: The registration fee includes a 2 hour workshop for 4-Hers to engage in a variety of unique STEAM challenges and social play experiences. The workshop activities will combine focused mental and hands-on projects with kinesthetic learning and play.

Q: Does the workshop registration fee include admission to the Amazeum?

A: The workshop fee does not include admission to the Amazeum.



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Q: Who are the educators of the 4-H workshops?

A: The Amazeum education team consists of highly qualified and trained Programs Educators. These Programs Educators work closely with our Educational Programs Manager to design and facilitate experiences that are engaging, unique, developmentally appropriate and fun for all. An Amazeum education team member will be actively present at all times during the workshop.

Q: When does workshop registration open?

A: Workshops are currently open for registration through the Amazeum's Reservation Specialist. Registration closes a week prior to the workshop.

Q: Is there a required chaperone to 4-H Leader ratio during the workshop?

A: The Amazeum requires a minimum of one adult to 10 4-Hers during both the workshop.

Q: Can parents/adult guardians or siblings attend the workshop?

A: In order to foster a cohesive experience, workshops are designed for 4-Hers and their leaders that have registered for the workshop. Additional adults or siblings will not be granted admission into the workshop. Non-participating adult guardians and siblings are welcome to join the 4-Her after the workshop.

Q: What is the size of the workshops?

A: Workshops are for up to 25 4-Hers and their leaders. If the workshop does not reach a minimum of 10 4-Hers, the workshop will be cancelled. If the Amazeum cancels the workshop due to low registration, refunds will be issued.
