
This a map of the Amazeum. We will now take a look at what's inside.

materials and tools.








This is The Market. You can pretend to shop as a customer or be a cashier!







This is the Hershey's Lab. You get to do science experiments with candy, but remember not to taste the candy without permission.




Did you know there is a REAL semi truck in the Amazeum? There you can pick up and move different items.



If things get a little loud, are too bright, or you need a space that's calm, you can take a break in our Cloud Theater.








In the Nickelodeon PlayLab, you can play with characters or make silly videos! This area makes a lot of noise!

Have you ever been in a log cabin? The Amazeum has a cabin where you can play with pretend animals and plants.










Our weather and nature area is where you can interact with exhibits to see how the environment works.
