



Connect, Mingle, Play Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Connect, Mingle, Play?

A: Connect, Mingle, and Play is designed for parents/caregivers with children ages 3-6 years old. Enjoy a night at the Amazeum to connect with local resources, mingle with other caregivers, and explore hands-on activities that support your child's learning. Come alone, bring a friend or bring your little - Amazeum educators will be onsite to provide supervised play while parents/caregivers attend the workshop.

Q: How do I sign up for Connect, Mingle, Play?

A: You can register to attend [online](#) through the Amazeum website in the 'Programs' menu by selecting 'Early Learners'.

Q: Is there a discount for Amazeum members?

A: Yes! Amazeum members enjoy a discount on registration and early access to register for programs.

Q: Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

A: Yes, the Amazeum will send you an email confirming your online registration. Please check your spam folder and inbox for the email confirmation.

Q: How do you recommend children dress for Connect, Mingle, Play?

A: Dress for fun and active play. We know it might be a late night for some of the kiddos so they can come in their pajamas if you'd like! Closed toed shoes are recommended and smocks are available if needed.

Q: Who will be with my child(ren) during the event?

A: The Amazeum education team consists of highly qualified and trained Early Learner Educators. These Early Learning Educators along with other educators such as our Play Facilitators and Programs Educators will supervise children in a portion of the exhibit hall and engage with them in a fun activity while the adults hear from great resources in our community and have their own fun upstairs.

Q: Do I have to bring my kids?

A: Not at all! Kids are welcome, and supervision will be provided, but feel free to make it a date night, come with friends, or come alone and meet new friends!

Q: What does the check-in process look like?

A: An Amazeum educator will greet you in the lobby to get checked in for the event.

- *If you have children with you, you will check them in with our Amazeum Educators who will be in our Exhibit Hall. Finally, make your way upstairs to our Learning Lofts where you will be invited to enjoy a lite bite, mingle with other caregivers, hear from great resources in our community about topics that matter to you, and have fun! Towards the end of the event, our Amazeum*

Educators will bring the children upstairs to the Learning Lofts to enjoy an activity with their adults before going home.

- *If you are not coming with children*, you can go directly up to the Learning Lofts where you will be invited to enjoy a lite bite, mingle with other caregivers, hear from great resources in our community about topics that matter to you, and have fun.

Q: I need to cancel my registration. How do I cancel and can I get a refund?

A: At this time we are unable to offer refunds for canceled registrations. Please plan your schedule accordingly so that you can attend your selected program.

If the Amazeum cancels a program due to low registration or weather, registration can be transferred to an upcoming workshop.
