

#### Early Learner Programs Frequently Asked Questions

## Q: What programs are available for children under 6 years old?

**A:** Amazeum offers several programs for children 0-6 years old and their adults/caregivers:

- Little Tinkerers: ages 3-6 years old and adult play partner
- You + Me = Play: ages 0-2 years old and adult play partners
- You + Me = Play: ages 3-5 years old and adult play partners
- Partners in Play: ages 0-6 years old and adult play partners

### Q: Do you offer any programs for parents/caregivers?

**A:** Yes! Connect, Mingle, and Play is designed for parents/caregivers with children ages 3-6 years old. Enjoy a night at the Amazeum to connect with local resources, mingle with other caregivers, and explore hands-on activities that support your child's learning. Come alone, bring a friend or bring your little - Amazeum educators will be onsite to provide supervised play while parents/caregivers attend the workshop.

### Q: How do I sign up for an early learner program?

**A:** You can sign up for each series <u>online</u> through the Amazeum website. In the 'Programs' menu, select 'Early Learners' to find your program of interest. All programs required advanced registration and payment, except Partners in Play. Partners in Play is included in the daily admission.

#### Q: Is there a discount for Amazeum members?

**A:** Yes! Amazeum members enjoy a discount on registration and early access to register for programs.

#### Q: Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

**A:** Yes, the Amazeum will send you an email confirming your online registration. Please check your spam folder and inbox for the email confirmation.

#### Q: How do you recommend children dress for early learner programs?

**A:** Dress for fun, active and potentially messy play. Closed toed shoes are recommended and smocks are available if needed.

#### Q: Who are the educators of the early learner programs?

**A:** The Amazeum education team consists of highly qualified and trained Early Learning Educators. These Early Learning Educators work closely with our Early Learning Initiatives Manager to design and facilitate experiences that are engaging, unique, developmentally appropriate and fun for children ages 0-6. An Amazeum education team member will be actively present at all times during the series.

#### Q: We are early birds at our house. Is it okay if we arrive early for the series?

**A:** Programs will begin promptly at the start time listed in the program description. Please arrive on time but no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the listed start time.

#### Q: I need to cancel my registration. How do I cancel and can I get a refund?

**A:** At this time we are unable to offer refunds for canceled registrations. Please plan your schedule accordingly so that you can attend your selected program.

If the Amazeum cancels a program due to low registration or weather, registration can be transferred to an upcoming workshop.
