Q: What is the fee for a Scout workshop?

A: Scout workshops are \$15 per Scout. The den/troop leader and co-leader attend the workshop at no cost and are expected to serve as active chaperones during the workshop experience. For Lion and Tiger workshops, one adult leader per Lion/Tiger Scout is free.

For all Girl Scout workshops, there is a \$2 processing fee for registrations through the Girl Scouts - Diamonds of Arkansas, Oklahoma and Texas Council.

Q: How do I register for a workshop?

A: Den/troop leaders should register the Scouts in their den/troop for the workshops. The workshops are designed to be a collaborative experience for dens/troops rather than individual Scouts.

Cub Scout workshops registration is available through the Amazeum's Reservation Specialist by calling 479-268-4542 or emailing at reservations@amazeum.org. Advanced registration and payment is required. Registration closes at noon the Friday before the workshop.

Girl Scout workshops registration is available through the Girl Scouts - Diamonds of Arkansas, Oklahoma and Texas Council [website](#). Advanced registration and payment is required.

Q: I'm not a den/troop leader but I want to sign up my child for a workshop. Can I register my child separately from a den/troop?

A: Due to the collaborative experience of the workshop, the den or troop leader should register the den/troop. Individual Scouts interested in attending the workshop should contact their den/troop leader.

Q: If a registered Scout is not able to attend, will I be able to get a refund?

A: Payment for the workshop is collected at the time of registration. At this time, refunds are not available once the registration has been confirmed.

Q: What does the workshop registration fee include?

A: The registration fee includes a 2 hour workshop of focused hands-on activities that meet specific requirements of the Girl Scout badge or Cub Scout loop/pin. The fee also includes time exploring the Amazeum exhibits to further the STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math) connections of the loop/pin/badge. The den/troop leader and co-leader are free and are expected to serve as chaperones during the workshop and exhibit exploration time. For Lion and Tiger workshops, one adult leader per Lion/Tiger Scout is free. Workshop registration fee does not include the physical badge, pin or loop. Please purchase separately from your Council store.

Q: When does workshop registration open?

A: Cub Scout workshops are currently open for registration through the Amazeum's Reservation Specialist.

Girl Scout workshops registration is available through the Girl Scout Council website. Please check the [website](#) for registration details.

Q: Is there a required chaperone to Scout ratio during the workshop and in the exhibit hall?

A: The Amazeum requires a minimum of one adult to 10 Scouts during both the workshop and exhibit exploration time. For Tiger workshops, the ratio is one adult to one Tiger Scout.

Q: During the workshop, will scouts play in the exhibits?

A: The two hour activity focused workshop is located in the Learning Loft or 3M Tinkering Hub. Scouts and their designated den/troop leader can continue the learning by playing in the exhibits after the workshop.

Q: What is Amazeum Fun Patch Event?

A: All levels of Girl Scout are taking over the museum for an exclusive, afterhours STEAM event! Scouts will be challenged to visit a certain number of stations in order to earn their unique Amazeum Fun Patch. Come play in the exhibit hall while completing hands-on STEAM challenges.

Advanced registration and payment is required. Registration for the Amazeum Fun Patch Event for Girl Scouts is available through the Amazeum's Reservation Specialist by calling 479-268-4542 or emailing at reservations@amazeum.org.

Q: Can parents/adult guardians or siblings attend the workshop or exhibit exploration time?

A: In order to foster a cohesive experience, workshops are designed for Scouts and their den/troop leaders that have registered for the workshop. Additional adults or siblings will not be granted admission into the workshop. Non-participating adult guardians and siblings are welcome to join the den/troop after the workshop for the exhibit exploration time. Please check in at the admissions desk to show your membership card or to purchase admission into the exhibit hall. An adult must accompany children in the museum. *Note: We recognize that some Scouts do not belong to a den/troop, and that their parents/guardians are effectively their den/troop leader.
