

Learning It Together Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Learning It Together workshops at the Scott Family Amazeum?

A: Learning It Together workshops are designed for caregivers and their 13-17-year-old to learn and create alongside one another. In the workshop, age barriers are broken down as teens and caregivers have the opportunity to be adventurous together, learning new skills and tools alongside one another as they make a collaborative piece to take home. Workshops are guided by our tinkering and making experts, so no prior experience is necessary for teens OR caregivers. All you need is a curious brain and a little maker courage!

Q: What ages are allowed to attend Learning It Together workshops at the Scott Family Amazeum?

A: The workshops are designed for caregivers and teens ages 13-17. Caregivers and teens must attend together. A caregiver will not be admitted without their registered teen, nor a teen without their registered caregiver.

Q: Is there a discount for Amazeum members?

A: Yes! Amazeum members enjoy a discount on registration and early access to registration.

Q: How do I sign up for the Learning It Together workshop?

A: You can sign up for each series <u>online</u> through the Amazeum website. In the 'Programs' menu, select 'Teens/Adults' to find your program of interest.

Q: Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

A: Yes, the Amazeum will send you an email confirming your online registration. Please check your spam folder and inbox for the email confirmation.

Q: How do you recommend teens dress for the Learning It Together workshops?

A: Workshop participants should dress appropriately. Closed-toe shoes are required. Do not wear loose fitting, gloves, jewelry, watches, or anything else dangling that might get caught in a piece of moving equipment. Long hair should be tied back. Personal protective equipment such as goggles and hearing protection will be provided as appropriate.

Q: We are early birds at our house. Is it okay if we arrive early for the workshop?

A: Learning It Together will begin promptly at the start time listed in the program description. Please arrive on time but no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the listed start time.

Q: I need to cancel my registration. How do I cancel and can I get a refund?

A: At this time we are unable to offer refunds for canceled registrations. Please plan your schedule accordingly so that you can attend your selected program.
