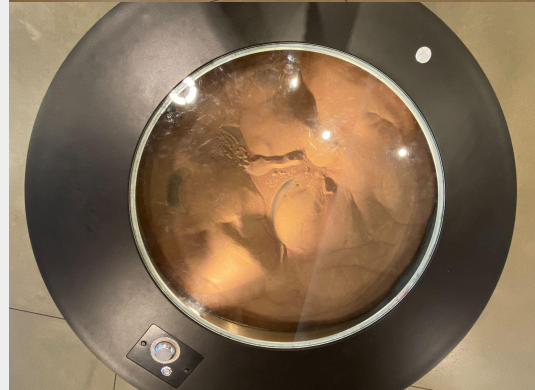
Have you ever been in a log cabin? The Amazeum has a cabin where you can play with pretend animals and plants.
