Toys: The Inside Story

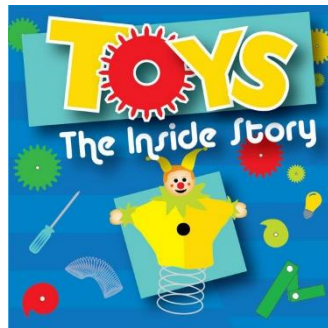
