4-H Programs

The Amazeum now offers private workshops designed for the 4-H community! 4-H members now have an amazing opportunity to expand their horizons and learn new skills with the Amazeum by engaging in science, technology, engineering, arts, and math (STEAM) related activities.

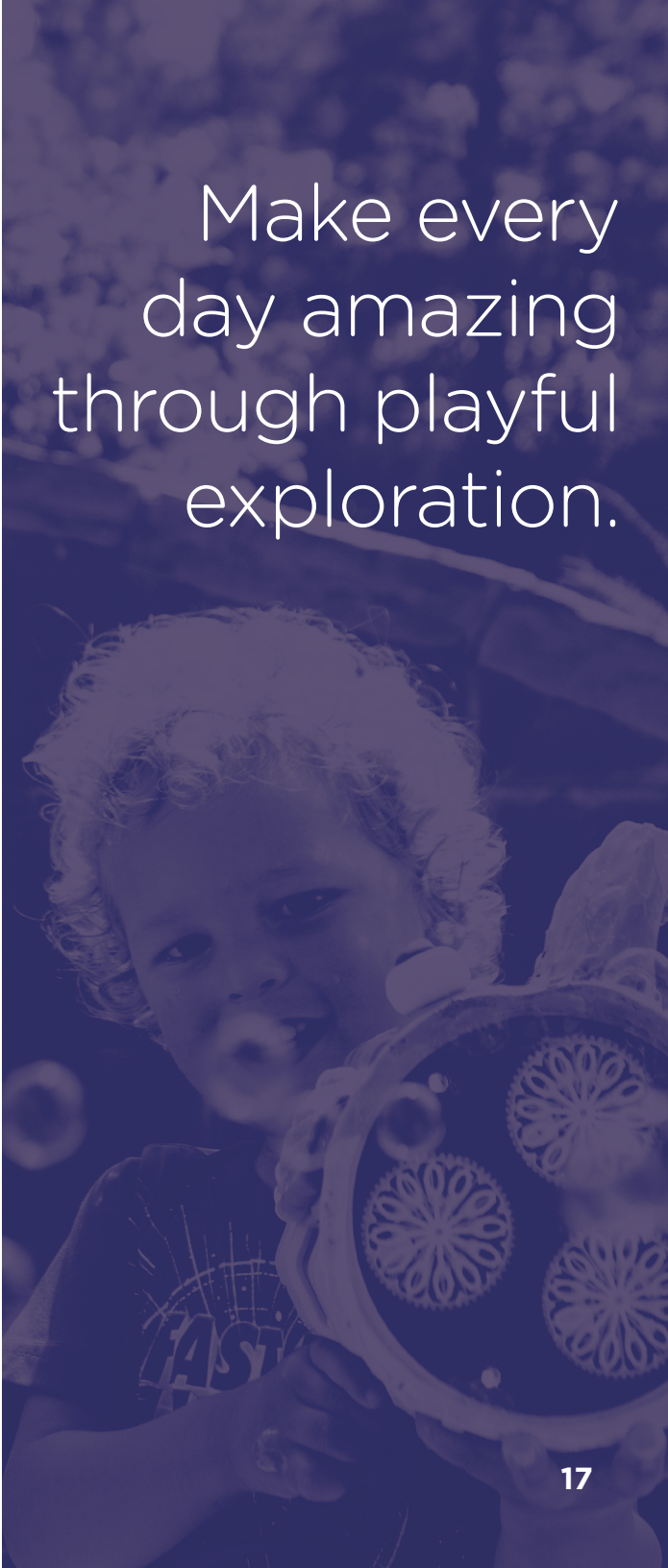
